## 📌 Overview

---

An immersive Himachal tour package and Himachal Adventure tour package that explores the sacred monasteries, high-altitude villages, and stark lunar landscapes of Spiti. ### Highlights:

- Kaza: regional hub with local markets and Tibetan culture
- Tabo Monastery: ancient murals and UNESCO-style significance
- Kibber & Komik: remote high-altitude villages and monasteries
- Key/Keylang Monastery (Kye) and Langza: fossil village & panoramic views
- Pin Valley & Dhankar: dramatic canyons and monasteries

Note: This 7 and 8 Himachal Adventure tour package is designed for moderate fitness and includes acclimatization time; travel durations are long due to mountain roads.

## Day-by-Day Itinerary

---

Day

1

### **Arrival and Drive to Sangla — Enter the Kinnaur Valley**

Morning arrival at the designated pick-up (Shimla/Recong Peo/Chandigarh transfer option). Scenic drive into Kinnaur Valley, passing orchards, terraced fields and the Baspa River. Check-in, short rest, and an evening walk in Sangla Bazaar. Tip: Keep layers handy — temperature drops after sunset.

### **Sangla to Kalpa — Apple Orchards & Kinnauri Culture**

After breakfast, ascend towards Kalpa, enjoying panoramic views of the Kinnaur Kailash range. Visit local villages, ancient temples, and viewpoint for sunset over snow-capped peaks. Evening cultural stroll in Kalpa village.

### **Kalpa to Tabo — Gateway to Spiti**

Long scenic drive bringing you into the stark yet beautiful Spiti landscape. Cross high passes and remote hamlets before arriving in Tabo. Evening at leisure; short introductory walk around the village to acclimatize. Important: Expect long driving segments — carry snacks, water, and motion-sickness remedies.

### **Explore Tabo & Dhankar — Ancient Monasteries and Cliff-Fort**

Full day discovering Tabo Monastery (often called the 'Ajanta of the Himalayas') with its exquisite frescoes. Afternoon excursion to Dhankar Monastery and the dramatic Dhankar Lake/viewpoint. Learn about local Tibetan Buddhist culture from resident monks.

### **Tabo to Kaza — Hikkim, Komic and Fossil Village Langza**

Drive to Kaza, stopping at iconic hamlets: Langza (fossil-hunting village with spectacular statue of Buddha), Hikkim (home to one of the world's highest post offices), and Komic (one of the world's highest villages). Evening arrival in Kaza — explore local market and acclimatize.

### **Kibber, Komik & Key Monastery — High-altitude Village Life**

Short drive to Kibber with time to visit Kibber Monastery and surrounding high-altitude plateaus. Visit Komik and Komic Monastery, and return via Key (Kye) Monastery perched above the valley. Afternoon birdwatching and village walks — possible sighting of Himalayan marmots and blue sheep.

## **Kaza Leisure & Optional Excursions — Pin Valley or Local Trails**

Day for local exploration or optional excursions: half-day trip into Pin Valley National Park (permits required) for remote hamlets and wildlife, or acid-test easy hikes around Kaza and Langza. Time for shopping, monastery chants, and photography at golden hour.

## **Departure — Return Drive**

After breakfast, begin the return drive to your drop-off point (Shimla/Chandigarh/Manali option as per booking). Enjoy last views of the Spiti landscape and final stops for photography. Note: Schedule varies depending on chosen exit route and road conditions.
