Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival in Mahé & Luxury Transfer

Arrive at Seychelles International Airport (Mahé). Meet your private driver and transfer in a luxury vehicle to your 5-star beachfront resort. Day

2

Mahé – Beach Day & Relaxation

Unwind after your flight. Enjoy a private beach cabana, couple's spa treatment (optional), and leisurely snorkeling from the shore. Sunset cocktails and personalized dinner arrangement on the beach.

This full day is designed for relaxation after travel and to acclimatize to island time.

Day

3

Mahé – Island Highlights & Culture

Guided island tour with a private driver-guide: visit Victoria (the world's smallest capital), Sir Selwyn Selwyn-Clarke Market, and the Seychelles National Botanical Gardens. Afternoon visit to Mission Lodge viewpoint for panoramic views. Evening at leisure with a special Creole cooking demonstration or private chef experience.

Note: Photography at viewpoints is spectacular during late afternoon light.

Day

4

Mahé – Marine Adventure & Optional Helicopter

Half-day private snorkeling cruise to nearby reefs with lunch on board. Option for a helicopter scenic flight over the Seychelles archipelago (book in advance) – an iconic way to see the mosaic of islands and turquoise lagoons. Evening: sunset yacht cruise with champagne.

Optional experiences like helicopter flights must be booked at the time of confirmation.

Day

5

Transfer to Praslin – Vallée de Mai Introduction

Private transfer to the jetty and high-speed ferry (or domestic flight) to Praslin. Check into a luxury boutique resort. Afternoon guided visit to Vallée de Mai to see the famed coco de mer palms and endemic birdlife. Romantic dinner on-property with sea views.

Ferries are scenic but can be delayed due to weather; domestic flights reduce travel time.

Day

6

Praslin – Anse Lazio & Beach Leisure

Spend the day at Anse Lazio, often listed among the world's top beaches. Swim, snorkel, and enjoy a beach picnic arranged by your resort. Late afternoon visit to a viewpoint for sunset photography.

Anse Lazio is ideal for calm water swimming and snorkeling; bring reef-safe sunscreen.

Day

7

Praslin – Curieuse Island Conservation & Giant Tortoises

Full-day island-hopping excursion to Curieuse Island (marine park): guided nature walk to meet the giant tortoises, mangrove boardwalk, and snorkeling on pristine reefs. Gourmet beach barbecue lunch included. Return to Praslin for a relaxed evening.

Wildlife encounters are best in the morning; wear comfortable shoes and a hat.

8

Transfer to La Digue & Cycling Discovery

Short ferry ride to La Digue. Check into a charming luxury villa. No cars on La Digue – explore the island by bicycle with a private guide. Visit local artisan shops, traditional boatyards, and enjoy a casual lunch at a beachfront café.

La Digue's relaxed pace is perfect for couples and photographers.

Day

9

La Digue – Anse Source d'Argent & Sunset Cruise

Morning at the iconic Anse Source d'Argent – famed for its pink sand, granite boulders, and crystal-clear shallows. Afternoon at leisure or optional guided nature walk to inland trails. Evening private sunset cruise with canapés and champagne as you head back to Mahé or proceed to your private island transfer route.

Anse Source d'Argent can be busy in midday; early morning provides the best light and fewer crowds.

Day

10

Private Island Retreat & Butler Introduction

Speedboat or helicopter transfer to your Private Island Retreat. Welcome by your personal butler who will brief you on the villa, private dining options, and bespoke experiences. Afternoon couple's spa ritual, secluded beach time, and private chef-prepared dinner on the sand.

Ensure international flight timings allow for inter-island transfer windows; we recommend midday or evening departures where possible.

🔗 Frequently Asked Questions

🔗 What's the best time to visit Seychelles from India?

The ideal time depends on your priorities. April-May and October-November offer the best overall conditions with light winds, calm seas, and excellent underwater visibility—perfect for snorkeling and diving. June-August brings cooler, drier weather with southeast trade winds, ideal for hiking and surfing. December-March can be wetter with brief tropical showers but features great diving conditions in October-November. For Indian travelers, avoid the monsoon period back home (June-September) by visiting during Seychelles' calmer months. Peak season pricing occurs around Christmas/New Year, so shoulder seasons (April-May, October-November) offer the best value with optimal weather conditions.

❓ **How can I reach Seychelles from India and what are the flight options?**

Seychelles International Airport (SEZ) on Mahé is the main gateway. From India, you have seasonal nonstop flights (typically 4.5–5 hours from Mumbai/Delhi) or one-stop connections via Middle Eastern hubs like Dubai, Doha, or Abu Dhabi (7–10 hours total). Airlines like Emirates, Qatar Airways, and Etihad offer reliable connections. Air Seychelles sometimes operates direct seasonal routes. Book well in advance for better prices, especially during peak seasons. Once in Seychelles, domestic flights connect Mahé to Praslin (15 minutes), while ferries serve the main islands. Inter-island transfers should be pre-booked, particularly during peak periods.

❓ **Do Indian passport holders need a visa for Seychelles?**

Indian passport holders typically receive visa-free entry to Seychelles with a Visitor's Permit issued on arrival. However, you must meet standard requirements: valid passport (6+ months validity), confirmed return/onward ticket, proof of accommodation, and sufficient funds for your stay. The initial permit is usually valid for 30 days and can be extended. Requirements can change, so always verify current entry conditions with the Seychelles embassy or official tourism website before traveling. Ensure your passport has blank pages for entry stamps and carry printed copies of hotel bookings and return tickets as immigration may request them.

❓ **What are the local transportation options within Seychelles?**

Transportation varies by island. On Mahé and Praslin, public buses (SPTC) run extensive daytime routes at low cost. Rental cars offer the most freedom—driving is on the left with narrow, winding roads requiring caution. Taxis are readily available but more expensive. On La Digue, bicycles are the quintessential transport method, creating a charming, eco-friendly experience. For inter-island travel, fast catamarans connect Mahé–Praslin–La Digue, while domestic flights offer quick hops. Boat charters and water taxis provide access to smaller islands and snorkeling spots. Book inter-island transfers in advance during peak seasons, and always allow buffer time between connections and international flights.

❓ **What accommodation options are available and where should I stay?**

Seychelles offers accommodations across all budgets. Ultra-luxury resorts include Six Senses Zil Pasyon and Anantara Maia with private villas and world-class spas. Mid-range options feature boutique hotels like Coco de Mer Hotel on Praslin and Story Seychelles on Mahé. Budget travelers can choose government-licensed guesthouses offering authentic local experiences. Stay on Mahé for hiking, nightlife, and cultural attractions; Praslin for Vallée de Mai and Anse Lazio beach; La Digue for bicycle culture and Anse Source d'Argent. Many resorts are on private islands for ultimate seclusion. Book early for peak seasons, and note that even luxury resort beaches remain public by law.

Don't miss Anse Source d'Argent on La Digue—iconic granite boulders and crystal-clear waters create a photographer's paradise. Vallée de Mai on Praslin is a UNESCO World Heritage site housing the legendary coco-de-mer palms and rare black parrots. Anse Lazio on Praslin consistently ranks among the world's top beaches.
