Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Colonial Welcome in Shimla

Arrive at Shimla (Jaipur/Chandigarh to Shimla transfer or Kalka toy-train arrival) and transfer to your heritage hotel. Enjoy a warm welcome drink and a short orientation. Spend the afternoon settling in and exploring the hotel's colonial architecture and gardens. In the evening take a gentle stroll to The Ridge and Mall Road for leisure shopping and an introduction to Shimla's historic charm.

Overnight at a luxury heritage hotel in Shimla.

Day

2

Kufri Excursion & Himalayan Views

After breakfast, take a scenic drive to Kufri (approx. 20–30 minutes). Visit the Himalayan Nature Park and enjoy panoramic views of the snow-capped ranges from the Kufri viewpoints. Options include short horse rides or a visit to the small amusement area – family-friendly and easily accessible.

Return to Shimla for an evening high tea at a heritage café and leisure time at the hotel.

Tip: Carry a light jacket – temperatures at Kufri are cooler and windier.

Day

3

Shimla Heritage Walk & Viceregal Lodge

Begin the day with a guided heritage walk through Shimla's colonial quarter. Visit landmarks including the Viceregal Lodge (Indian Institute of Advanced Study), the Christ Church, and historic colonial bungalows. Explore the Lodge's manicured lawns and stately interiors (subject to visiting hours).

Afternoon at leisure – enjoy optional activities such as a photography walk or a family picnic in the pine-clad slopes.

Important: Viceregal Lodge may have restricted access on certain days; alternative visits will be arranged if required.

Day

4

Mashobra & Naldehra Countryside Retreat

Drive to the serene valleys of Mashobra and Naldehra (approx. 30–45 minutes). Enjoy a leisurely nature walk under pine canopies and visit the famed Naldehra Golf Course for photos and light recreation. This day is planned as a gentle countryside retreat — ideal for families and those seeking calm outdoor time.

Return to Shimla for an evening spa session or in-hotel leisure activities.

Tip: Great day for kids — open spaces and easy trails.

Day

5

Leisure Day: Spa, Heritage High Tea & Optional Toy Train

A relaxed day to enjoy hotel amenities: indulge in a spa treatment, join a colonial-era high tea, or shop for local handicrafts on Mall Road. For guests who prefer an excursion, an optional half-day ride on the Kalka–Shimla toy train (subject to availability and advance booking) can be arranged — a nostalgic journey through tunnels and viaducts.

Evening: Farewell dinner with a curated Himachali tasting menu at your hotel.

Note: Toy train seats must be booked in advance; inform us if you'd like this option.

Day

6

Departure from Shimla

After breakfast, check out from your heritage hotel and transfer to your onward connection (Chandigarh/Delhi by road or Kalka by rail). Depending on your flight/train schedule, enjoy a last stroll on The Ridge or purchase final souvenirs.

We recommend scheduling return travel with sufficient buffer time given mountain road conditions.
