## Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

### **Arrival & Easy Day in Manali**

Arrive at Manali (via road from Chandigarh/Delhi or local connector). Check-in at your hotel and relax to acclimatize to the altitude. Evening at leisure to stroll Mall Road, enjoy local cafes, and shop for winter gear. Tip: Keep warm layers handy for the evening—temperatures drop after sundown.

### **Manali Local Sightseeing**

After breakfast, explore the cultural and scenic highlights of Manali. Visit the ancient Hadimba Devi Temple, the atmospheric Old Manali lanes, and the natural hot springs at Vashisht. Spend the afternoon visiting the Manali Manalsu local markets and enjoying panoramic views. Evening free to experience the lively mountain ambience.

### **Solang Valley — Snow Adventure Day**

Transfer to Solang Valley early for a full day of winter adventure. Participate in snowmobiling, snow zorbing, tubing, and build snow sculptures. Optional supervised paragliding (seasonal and weather-permitting) and photography sessions in pristine snowfields. Return to your Solang camp/homestay for a cozy evening by the bonfire.

Important: Activities are subject to weather and safety checks; guides will brief you before each activity.

### **Rohtang Pass / Atal Tunnel Excursion (Subject to Permits)**

Early morning drive towards Rohtang Pass or the scenic Atal Tunnel and Gulaba region depending on road access and permit availability. Enjoy expansive snowy vistas and crisp mountain air. Spend the day taking in high-altitude panoramas, capturing photos, and experiencing raw Himalayan beauty.

Note: Rohtang access requires permits and may be closed mid-winter. Alternatives include a longer sightseeing circuit via Atal Tunnel to Keylong/Gulaba viewpoints.

### **Adventure & Leisure — Ice Activities and Local Exploration**

Dedicate this day to additional snow activities or relax with light treks around Solang and Manali. Options include guided snow treks, ice-skating (where available), more snowmobiling, or a photography walk. Enjoy local Himachali cuisine and a cultural evening with music around the campfire.

Tip: Carry waterproof boots and sunscreen—the reflection off snow can be intense even on cloudy days.

## Departure from Manali

After breakfast, check out and transfer back to your onward destination (Chandigarh/Delhi or next connection). Exchange contact details with local guides for future trips and collect memories from an invigorating winter escape.
