## Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

### **Arrival in Shimla & Leisurely Evening**

In the evening, enjoy a gentle stroll along Mall Road and the Ridge, soaking up colonial architecture and mountain air. Tip: Keep the first day relaxed to adjust to altitude and travel fatigue.

### **Drive to Sangla Valley — Settle into Baspa's Beauty**

After breakfast, depart for Sangla (Baspa Valley) via scenic mountain roads. Check in to a carefully selected boutique homestay or riverside lodge. Spend the afternoon exploring Sangla Bazaar, strolling along the Baspa River, and relaxing in the property with Himalayan views. Evening at leisure with a locally-curated dinner.

### **Chitkul Excursion — The Last Inhabited Village**

Full day excursion to Chitkul, the last inhabited Indian village near the Indo-Tibetan border (subject to local road/permit conditions). Enjoy an easy valley walk, alpine meadows, and unobstructed views of the surrounding peaks. Return to Sangla in the evening for a cozy fireside dinner. Note: Roads can be narrow; travel times vary with weather.

### **Sangla to Kalpa — En Route to Kinnaur's Apple Country**

Drive towards Kalpa, passing through Reckong Peo — the administrative heart of Kinnaur. Stop en route for panoramic views of the Sutlej and local villages. Arrive at Kalpa and check into a boutique mountain hotel with uninterrupted views of the Kinner Kailash range. Evening at leisure; enjoy a sunset viewpoint and a romantic dinner.

### **Kalpa — Kinner Kailash Views & Village Walks**

A relaxed day dedicated to exploring Kalpa and surrounding hamlets. Visit Roghi and nearby apple orchards, enjoy village walks, and witness the spectacular sunrise over Kinner Kailash. Option for a short guided cultural walk and tea with a local family. Perfect day for honeymoon photography and slow travel.

### **Kalpa to Nako — High-Altitude Serenity**

After breakfast, drive to Nako, a quaint village known for Nako Lake and its serene monastery. On arrival, check-in to a traditional guesthouse. Spend the afternoon exploring the lake, walking to the nearby monastery, and capturing reflections of the mountains on the water. Evening free for stargazing and quiet moments.

## **Nako to Reckong Peo — Local Markets & Cultural Touchpoints**

Depart for Reckong Peo after breakfast. Explore the town, local markets, and nearby cultural spots. Option to visit small temples or a local museum. Check into a comfortable boutique property for a farewell dinner featuring regional cuisine. Tip: Pick up local handicrafts and Kinnauri apples as souvenirs.

## **Departure — Drop to Shimla / Transfer Point**

After breakfast, check out and transfer to Shimla or your preferred rail/roadhead for onward travel. En route, stop at scenic viewpoints for last photographs. Tour concludes with drop at Shimla station/airport or Chandigarh (as per your transfer plan). We recommend booking onward travel in the afternoon to accommodate mountain travel times.
