Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival, Check-in & Fort Kochi Sunset Walk

Later, take a short drive to Cherai Beach for a family-friendly beach experience (swimming and relaxation). Return to Kochi for a relaxing Sunset Harbour Cruise around Willingdon Island – a peaceful way to view the city from the water and watch the sunset over the Arabian Sea.

Leisure Morning & Departure

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and optional last-minute shopping at MG Road or the local spice markets. Check out from hotel and transfer to Cochin airport or railway station for your onward journey. If you have a late departure, consider a short visit to the nearby spice market or a café for final souvenirs.
