Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival in Kochi and Fort Kochi Evening

Arrive at Cochin International Airport and transfer to your boutique hotel in Kochi. Spend the afternoon strolling through Fort Kochi – see the iconic Chinese Fishing Nets, St. Francis Church, and the colorful streets of Jew Town. Enjoy a relaxed dinner at a waterfront restaurant. Tip: If time permits, visit the German Bakery or a short spice market walk.

Day

2

Transfer to Marari Beach Villa – Arrival & Relaxation

After breakfast, transfer (approx. 1–1.5 hrs) to your private Marari Beach villa. Check in and meet your private chef who will introduce the villa dining plan. Spend the afternoon on the palm-fringed beach, swim in the sea, or enjoy a refreshing coconut. Evening includes a curated seafood dinner prepared by your private chef on the terrace. Note: Villa staff can arrange a seaside bonfire (subject to local regulations).

Day

3

Beach Leisure, Private Chef Demo & Village Walk

Start the day with a guided Kerala cooking class led by your private chef—learn to prepare classic dishes like fish curry and appam. Spend the afternoon relaxing on the beach or take a guided walk through the nearby fishing village to learn traditional life along the coast. Evening at leisure with a chef-curated tasting menu. Tip: Capture sunrise photos from the western end of the beach – best for soft morning light.

Day

4

Alleppey (Alappuzha) Backwater Day Cruise

Full-day private boat cruise on the Vembanad Lake and Alleppey backwaters. Experience winding canals, coir-making hamlets, and local waterways. Enjoy a freshly prepared lunch onboard by your private chef or arranged by the villa team. Return to Marari by late afternoon for a sunset walk. Optional upgrade: Overnight traditional houseboat available on request.

Day

5

Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary Excursion or Wellness Day

Choose between a half-day birdwatching trip to Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary (great for migratory species, early morning recommended) or a villa-based Ayurvedic wellness session (massage, herbal steam). Afternoon at leisure – enjoy a seaside spa treatment or a private seafood barbecue prepared by your chef on the beach. Tip: Birdwatchers should bring binoculars and a light jacket for early mornings.

Day

6

Leisure, Cultural Activities & Farewell Dinner

A final full day to soak up the Kerala coast: morning yoga or paddle along the shallow coastline, afternoon optional visit to local coir workshops, and an evening farewell chef's tasting menu featuring Kerala specialties and fresh catch of the day. Note: Staff can arrange a traditional cultural performance (Kathakali or local art) at the villa for an additional charge.

7

Checkout and Departure via Kochi

After breakfast, check out and transfer back to Cochin International Airport (approx. 1–1.5 hrs). Depending on flight timings, enjoy a short stop in Fort Kochi or Cherai Beach on the way. End of the Luxury Coastal Retreat. Important: Confirm your flight schedule with the villa team at least 24 hours in advance.
