Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival, Bhuj Bazaar & Heritage Walk

Arrive at Bhuj and transfer to your comfortable hotel. After check-in and refresh, take a guided heritage walk through Bhuj Bazaar. Visit Aina Mahal and Prag Mahal to learn about Kutch's royal past. Explore the bustling bazaars for handcrafted textiles, silver jewelry, and local snacks. Evening at leisure — optional dinner at a local eatery.

Tip: Carry small change for street purchases and be ready for vibrant bargaining.

Day

2

Bhujodi Weavers & Ajrakhpur — Traditional Textiles

Drive short distances to the weaving village of Bhujodi. Meet master weavers and watch the weaving process; enjoy a hands-on demonstration and shopping opportunity. Continue to Ajrakhpur (Ajrakh block-printing village) to see the ancient resist-dye technique that produces the iconic Ajrakh prints. Return to Bhuj for dinner.

Special note: Bhujodi and Ajrakh demonstrations make this ideal for families wanting interactive craft experiences.

Day

3

Nirona: Rogan Art, Copper Smiths & Village Life

Head to Nirona village, celebrated for the rare Rogan painting art. Spend time with Rogan artists and watch the delicate hand-painting process. Visit copper and metal workshops nearby and learn about traditional techniques that have been preserved for generations. Return to Bhuj in the evening or proceed towards Dhordo depending on timing.

Note: Rogan art demonstrations are time-bound; the guide will coordinate timings for the best experience.

Day

4

Kalo Dungar, White Desert Sunset & Rann Cultural Evening

Depart early for Kalo Dungar (Black Hill) for sweeping views over the Rann and the historic Dattatreya temple. Proceed to the Great Rann of Kutch at Dhordo. Spend the afternoon exploring the salt flats, then experience a dramatic sunset over the white expanse. Participate in village interactions and attend an evening cultural program showcasing Kutchi music and dance.

Highlight: Sunset and the cultural performance are memorable family-friendly experiences — bring a light jacket for the evenings on the Rann.

Day

5

Rann Sunrise, Local Markets & Departure

Optional early-morning visit to the Rann for sunrise (highly recommended). Return to Bhuj with stops at local craft bazaars for last-minute shopping — pick up bandhani, mirror-work textiles, and handcrafted souvenirs. Transfer to Bhuj airport/railway station for onward journey.

Tip: Confirm your departure schedule in advance; optional add-ons like extended homestays or extra nights at Rann can be arranged.
