Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Bhuj Introduction

Arrive at Bhuj (airport/railway). Meet and transfer to your hotel. Spend the afternoon settling in and exploring nearby markets and local life. Evening visit to Bhuj Market and a short orientation briefing about the Gujarat tour package and logistics for the next days. Tip: Carry light layers — Bhuj evenings can be cooler.

Day

2

Bhuj Heritage & Handicraft Villages

Full-day exploration of Bhuj's cultural heart. Visit the Kutch Museum, Aina Mahal and Prag Mahal to understand the regions history and architecture. Afternoon visit to Bhujodi and Hodka (handloom and tribal crafts villages) where local weavers and artisans demonstrate their skills. Great for picking authentic Kutch textiles, bandhani and tie-dye crafts — perfect for a Gujarat Family Retreat tour package shopping stop.

Day

3

Kalo Dungar & Transfer to Dhordo

Drive to Kalo Dungar (Black Hill) — the highest point in Kutch — to enjoy panoramic views and the famous Indroda (India) Bridge viewpoint. Continue to Dhordo, the gateway to the Great Rann. Evening arrival, check-in and short sunset visit to the salt plains for your first taste of the white desert. Important: Rann visits are best at sunrise/sunset for photography and cooler temperatures.

Day

4

Sunrise Over the White Desert & Cultural Village Visit

Witness an unforgettable sunrise over the Great Rann of Kutch — the vast white salt horizon. After breakfast, explore nearby villages to meet local artisan families and learn about mud architecture and handicrafts. Afternoon at leisure or optional cultural activities (folk music/dance demonstration). Evening free to enjoy a starlit desert ambiance.

Day

5

Rann Exploration & Drive to Dholavira

Morning exploration of lesser-known Rann spots and photo stops. After an early lunch, depart for Dholavira — a drive across scenic Kutch landscapes bringing you to one of Indias most significant Harappan archaeological sites. Evening arrival at Dholavira, check-in and short briefing for next day's archaeological tour. Note: Road stretches can be remote — carry water and essentials.

Day

6

Dholavira Archaeological Excavation Tour

Full-day guided visit to Dholavira — the well-preserved Harappan city. Explore fortified citadel remains, water reservoirs, unique town planning, and the museum onsite. Your local guide will explain the site's historical context and recent discoveries. Return to the hotel and enjoy a relaxed evening reflecting on ancient Gujarat history.

Day

7

Drive to Mandvi & Beach Relaxation

Depart Dholavira after breakfast and drive to Mandvi. On arrival, relax at Mandvi Beach, visit the historic Vijay Vilas Palace, and see the traditional Mandal ship-building yard. Evening free for beach time, local cuisine sampling and a calm family-friendly atmosphere – a gentle finale to your Gujarat Family Retreat package.

Departure via Bhuj

After breakfast, transfer to Bhuj for onward travel to the airport/railway station. En route you may stop for last-minute shopping or photos. Departure and tour conclusion. Safe travels! Consider adding extra nights if you want to explore more of Gujarat.
