Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival at Mandvi & Beachside Relaxation

Arrive at Mandvi (arrival by road/train/flight to nearest station). Check in to your beach-facing hotel or resort. Spend the afternoon unwinding on Mandvi Beach, known for its wide sandy stretch and calm waters—perfect for families and children. Evening stroll along the shore and optional visit to the bustling Mandvi Bazaar for local crafts and snacks. Tip: Check-in times vary; early arrival may be accommodated subject to availability.

Day

2

Water Activities & Vijay Vilas Palace

Start the day with family-friendly water activities: kayaking, banana boat rides, and gentle snorkeling sessions (age and weather permitting). After lunch, visit the picturesque Vijay Vilas Palace set amidst manicured gardens—the palace is a great photo stop and introduces the region’s royal history. Evening leisure at the beach with a bonfire (seasonal) and cultural folk performances if available. Important: Water-sport participation depends on weather and operator schedules; children may require life jackets and guardian supervision.

Day

3

Mandvi Leisure Morning & Transfer to Diu

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Mandvi—walk along the jetty, visit local workshops (furniture and shipbuilding heritage), or opt for a quick beachside cycle. After lunch, check out and drive to Diu (approx. 5–7 hours depending on route and stops). En route, short stops for photos and refreshments. Arrive in Diu, check in, and enjoy a quiet seaside dinner. Note: The transfer is a scenic drive—carry light luggage and essential medications.

Day

4

Diu Fort, Naida Caves & Nagoa Beach

Full day exploring Diu. Visit the historic Diu Fort with panoramic sea views and bastions, followed by the intriguing Naida Caves—a natural rock formation great for kids to explore. Relax at Nagoa Beach, Diu’s most famous crescent-shaped beach, ideal for swimming and sand play. Sunset views from the fort or beach front. Tip: Carry sunscreen and hats—southern Gujarat sun can be strong in afternoons.

Day

5

Water Adventures & Island Cruise

Enjoy a half-day of water adventures: parasailing, jet-ski rides, and a family-friendly glass-bottom boat or island cruise to observe marine life (seasonal availability). Afternoon leisure time for shopping at Diu Market—pick up seashell handicrafts and local sweets. Evening cultural stroll by the harbor with optional seafood dinner for adults. Important: Adventure activities have age/weight restrictions and safety briefings.

Day

6

Heritage Walk & Leisure Beach Day

Morning heritage walk visiting colonial-era landmarks, churches, and lighthouses. Spend the rest of the day at leisure: beach games, pool time at the resort, or a family photoshoot on the sand. Optional visit to quieter beaches like Ghoghla Beach for a serene afternoon. Wrap up with a farewell dinner featuring local Kathiawadi and coastal cuisine. Tip: Pre-book any specialty dining or photography sessions to secure preferred slots.

Departure from Diu

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Diu Airport/Nearest Railway Station or start your onward road journey. Assistance provided for transfers as per the package. Important: Confirm departure timings and allow buffer for traffic; carry copies of travel documents.
