Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival, Heritage & Sunset in Ahmedabad

Arrive at Ahmedabad airport/railway station and meet your private transfer. Start with a relaxed heritage tour: visit the Sabarmati Ashram, stroll the char bagh and learn about Gandhi's life. Continue to the ornate Adalaj Stepwell. In the evening enjoy a romantic heritage walk or rooftop dinner in the old city. Overnight in Ahmedabad.

Travel tip: Keep light layers for evening; heritage walks can be chilly in winter.

Day

2

Ahmedabad to Bhuj – Kutch Culture & Handicrafts

Fly/drive to Bhuj (or morning transfer). Explore the cultural heart of Kutch: Aina Mahal, Prag Mahal, and the Kutch Museum. Visit local handicraft bazaars for traditional bandhani, embroidery and lacquerware – perfect for honeymoon keepsakes. Evening at leisure at your boutique heritage hotel.

Tip: Carry cash for small handicraft purchases; bargaining is common.

Day

3

Great Rann of Kutch & Kala Dungar Sunset

Full-day excursion to the Great Rann of Kutch. Visit the salt desert and take photos on the surreal white plains. Stop at Kala Dungar (Black Hill) for panoramic views and the mystical sunset – a perfect romantic moment. Return to Bhuj for another night.

Special: Arrange a private sunset picnic on the Rann (seasonal & subject to permissions).

Day

4

Bhuj to Mandvi – Coastal Relaxation & Palace Walk

Drive to Mandvi on the Kutch coast. Enjoy the soft sands of Mandvi Beach and a visit to the picturesque Vijay Vilas Palace (royal grounds and film locations). Check in to a private beach resort; the evening features a romantic private beach dinner and sunset strolls.

Highlight: Mandvi's quiet beaches are ideal for honeymooners seeking privacy.

Day

5

Mandvi to Dwarka – Sacred Coastal Town

After a leisurely morning at the beach, drive south along the coast to Dwarka. Check in and visit the revered Dwarkadhish Temple for evening aarti. Walk along Dwarka Beach and enjoy the coastal breeze. Overnight in Dwarka.

Note: Dress modestly at temples; shoes are removed before entry.

Day

6

Bet Dwarka & Scenic Drive to Somnath

Take a morning boat trip to Bet Dwarka (optional), known for its serene beaches and small temples. Later, drive to Somnath. In the evening attend the majestic aarti at the Somnath Temple overlooking the Arabian Sea – an emotional and romantic experience.

Tip: Boat trips depend on tides and weather; plan accordingly.

Day

7

Gir National Park – Lion Safari & Nature Retreat

Head to Gir (Sasan Gir) for wildlife and nature. Enjoy a guided jeep safari in the park searching for the Asiatic lion, along with sightings of deer, antelope and diverse birdlife. Return to your jungle lodge for a romantic dinner and stargazing.

Important: Safari slots are subject to park permits – pre-booking recommended.

Day

8

Return to Ahmedabad & Departure

Drive back to Ahmedabad (or transfer to the nearest airport/railway hub) for your onward journey. If time allows, stop en route for last-minute shopping or a quick city sighting. Drop-off at Ahmedabad airport/railway station marks the end of your Gujarat Honeymoon package.

Farewell tip: Pack local snacks like fafda or khakhra for the journey home.
