Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival in Ahmedabad — Transfer to Palitana

Day

2

Shatrunjaya Temples — Palitana VIP Climb & Guided Exploration

Palitana Spiritual Immersion: Early morning ascent to the famed Shatrunjaya Hills for an immersive temple experience. Enjoy VIP access arrangements, a private guide, and priority darshan at selected Jain temples. Learn about the hill's sacred history, sculptural details and ritual traditions.

Afternoon: Return to the hotel for a relaxed lunch and optional visit to local craft markets or a short heritage walk in the nearby town.

Important: The climb involves steps and gentle hiking — wear comfortable footwear and carry water.

Day

3

Drive to Somnath via Junagadh — En route heritage visits

Scenic Road Journey & Heritage Stops: Depart Palitana after breakfast for Somnath. En route, opt to visit Junagadh to see Uparkot Fort, Ashoka's rock edicts, and other heritage sites (time permitting).

Evening Arrival: Reach Somnath and check into a beachfront/premium hotel. Enjoy sunset views of the Arabian Sea and a relaxed coastal dinner.

Note: Travel times vary — this day includes a longer road transfer, so travel light and rest as needed.

Day

4

Somnath VIP Darshan & Triveni Sangam

Sunrise VIP Darshan: Experience a serene sunrise VIP darshan at the Somnath Temple with priority access and a brief private puja (subject to temple permissions). Learn the temple's history and rituals from a dedicated priest or guide.

Afternoon & Evening: Visit the Triveni Sangam, the light-and-sound show, and explore the Somnath coastline. Time for leisure or optional Ayurvedic spa sessions at your hotel.

Tip: Carry light, respectful attire for temple visits and maintain silence in sanctum areas.

5

Drive to Dwarka – Bet Dwarka Boat Ride & Dwarkadhish VIP Visit

Coastal Drive to Dwarka: After an early breakfast, depart for Dwarka. On arrival, take a short boat ride (weather permitting) to Bet Dwarka – explore the island shrine and enjoy a calm, spiritual atmosphere.

Evening VIP Experience: Return for an exclusive Dwarkadhish Temple darshan arranged to offer priority access where possible. Visit Rukmini Temple and other nearby sacred spots.

Important: Boat transfers to Bet Dwarka depend on sea and port conditions; alternatives include a visit to nearby temples and the Dwarka lighthouse.

Return to Ahmedabad – Departure

Final Day & Departure: After breakfast, begin the drive back to Ahmedabad for your onward flight/train. En route, choose an optional stop at Porbandar (Gandhi's birthplace) or a local handicraft outlet for souvenirs.

Drop-off: Arrive Ahmedabad and proceed to the airport/railway station for departure.
