Amber Fort, City Palace & Local Markets

Evening at leisure with optional shopping at Johari Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar for traditional jewellery, textiles and handicrafts.

Royal Experiences & Candlelight Dinner

Enjoy a relaxed morning, or choose an optional sunrise hot-air balloon experience (additional cost). Later visit the serene Sisodia Rani Garden or the artistic Albert Hall Museum.
