Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival, Relaxation & Evening Market Walk

Arrive in Jaipur (Sanganer/Jaipur Airport or railway station). Transfer to your hotel and check in. Spend the afternoon resting after your journey. In the evening enjoy a guided walk through the Pink City neighborhood: explore Johri Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar to get a first taste of local shopping, textiles, and street snacks. Wrap up with a welcome dinner featuring Rajasthani specialities at a recommended restaurant.

Important: Early check-in subject to availability; luggage storage provided if needed.

Day

2

Amber Fort & Hill Forts Excursion

After breakfast, drive to Amber (Amer) Fort. Explore the grandeur of the fort including the Sheesh Mahal (Hall of Mirrors) and the sprawling palaces. Option for a traditional elephant ride (subject to availability and regulations) or a jeep ascent to the fort. Continue to nearby Jaigarh Fort for panoramic views and the historic cannon, followed by a photo stop at Jal Mahal on the way back.

Evening at leisure at the hotel or opt for a traditional Rajasthani puppet show or cultural village dinner (Chokhi Dhani) – pre-booking recommended.

Day

3

City Palace, Jantar Mantar & Local Cuisine Experience

Morning visit to City Palace, the living royal complex showcasing museums and ornate courtyards. Walk to Jantar Mantar, the UNESCO-listed astronomical observatory. See the famed Hawa Mahal (outside view & photos). Enjoy a curated Rajasthani lunch at a heritage restaurant, followed by a guided Rajasthani cooking class or a food walk to sample sweets, snacks, and local chai.

Note: City Palace includes museum entry fees; moderate walking involved.

Day

4

Museums, Markets & Optional Activities

Visit Albert Hall Museum (State Museum) and Birla Mandir for panoramic city views. Afternoon free for personalized activities: shop on MI Road, discover boutique handicraft stores, or schedule an optional heritage photo shoot in Jaipur's pink lanes. Evening can include a folk dance performance or relaxed dinner at the hotel.

Tip: MI Road and Bapu Bazaar are ideal for purchasing block print fabrics, blue pottery, and silver jewelry. Carry small change and bargain politely.

Day

5

Morning at Leisure & Departure

Enjoy a relaxed morning—optional yoga session or final quick shopping run for souvenirs. Check out from the hotel and transfer to Jaipur Airport or railway station for your onward journey. End of the Heritage Jaipur & Amber Experience: Forts, Markets & Local Cuisine.

Important: Confirm departure transfer timing at least 24 hours in advance with the hotel or tour representative.
