Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Evening Orientation in Bikaner

Arrive in Bikaner (by train/flight/car). Transfer to your hotel, relax and enjoy an orientation meeting with your local guide. In the evening, take a short stroll or a guided walk through the historic lanes and markets.

Activities:

- Check-in and welcome briefing
- Sunset walk around local bazaars and handicraft shops
- Optional evening at Laxmi Niwas Palace (photo stop or heritage walk)

Tip: Carry light warm clothing for desert evenings (seasonal).

Day

2

Bikaner City Tour & Karni Mata Temple (Deshnok)

Full-day city tour covering Bikaner's royal and cultural highlights. Visit the imposing Junagarh Fort and explore its museums and courtyards. Head to Deshnok to visit the famous Karni Mata Temple (the Rat Temple) and experience local devotion and legends.

Activities:

- Guided tour of Junagarh Fort and its galleries
- Explore Rampuria Havelis and local architecture
- Visit Karni Mata (Deshnok) Temple
- Evening return to hotel; attend any festival rehearsals if scheduled

Important: Karni Mata Temple is a sacred site; dress modestly and follow temple rules.

Day

3

Camel Festival: Full-Day Cultural & Camel Events

Immerse yourself in the Bikaner Camel Festival — the centerpiece of this package. Enjoy camel races, camel beauty contests, folk dances, puppet shows, and traditional music. This day is designed for vibrant cultural immersion and photography opportunities.

Activities:

- Arrive at the festival grounds early to catch camel races
- Watch camel beauty contests, acrobatics, and folk performances
- Interact with camel breeders and learn about camel husbandry
- Evening transfer to a nearby Desert Camp for an overnight experience with cultural performances under the stars

Tip: Pack a good camera, sunscreen, and a hat. Festival schedule may vary; follow local guide updates.

Day

4

Desert Sunrise, Camel Safari & Camel Research Centre

Begin with a desert sunrise and an optional short camel safari from the camp. After breakfast, return to Bikaner and visit the National Research Centre on Camel (Camel Breeding Farm) to understand camel conservation and research initiatives.

Activities:

- Sunrise camel ride / desert photography session
- Breakfast at the camp and return to Bikaner
- Visit National Research Centre on Camel and Gajner area (time permitting)
- Free time for shopping—Bikaner is famous for bajra, sweets like Bikaneri bhujia, and textiles

Note: Desert activities are subject to weather conditions.

Day

5

Departure from Bikaner

After breakfast, check out from your hotel. Depending on your departure schedule, you may have time for last-minute shopping or a short photo stop at Laxmi Niwas Palace.

Activities:

- Transfer to Bikaner Railway Station / Airport or onward destination
- Assistance with onward travel arrangements
