## Day-by-Day Itinerary

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Day

1

### **Arrival — Transfer to Ajmer & Evening Darshan**

Arrival at Jaipur / Ajmer railway station or Jaipur airport. Meet and transfer to Ajmer (approx 2.5–3 hours from Jaipur). After check-in, visit the iconic Ajmer Sharif Dargah for evening darshan and qawwali (if scheduled). Leisurely walk around Ana Sagar Lake in the evening.

Tip: Carry a modest dress and headcover for shrine visits. Local guides can help with darshan procedures.

Day

2

### **Ajmer — Heritage & Spiritual Sites**

Full day exploring Ajmer's heritage and spiritual landmarks. Start with the ancient mosque and mosque-turned-school Adhai Din Ka Jhonpra followed by a visit to Taragarh Fort for panoramic views. Experience the intricate architecture at Nasiyan (Red) Jain Temple and enjoy local markets.

Important: Wear comfortable footwear for walking on hill forts and temple steps.

Day

3

### **Drive to Pushkar — Brahma Temple & Lake**

Short drive to Pushkar (approx 30–45 minutes). Visit the sacred Pushkar Lake — perform aarti or simply stroll along the ghats and explore the Brahma Temple, one of the very few temples dedicated to Lord Brahma. Afternoon time for relaxed shopping in Pushkar's colourful markets and handicraft lanes.

Note: Pushkar is pedestrian-friendly in the old-town area; expect crowds during festivals and the Pushkar Camel Fair season.

Day

4

### **Pushkar — Sunrise, Savitri Temple & Optional Activities**

Early morning visit to the ghats for sunrise and optional boat-time/puja at the lake. Ascend to Savitri Mata Temple on Ratnagiri Hill for sunset views over the town and desert. Afternoon at leisure — options include a gentle camel safari, village walk or visiting local artisan workshops.

Tip: Sunrise at the lake is a serene experience; carry a light shawl for early mornings.

Day

5

### **Pushkar to Nagaur — Nagaur Fort & Sufi Shrines**

Drive to Nagaur (approx 2–2.5 hours). Discover the imposing Nagaur Fort with its palaces, granaries and frescoed walls. Visit local Sufi shrines and learn about the region's syncretic spiritual traditions. Evening free to explore the town's quiet streets and bazaars.

Note: Nagaur is less touristy — ideal for travellers seeking offbeat heritage and peaceful pilgrim trails.

Day

6

### **Nagaur to Jaipur — Jaipur Evening & Markets**

Drive to Jaipur (approx 3–4 hours). On arrival, enjoy a short city orientation and evening at leisure. Walk through the lively markets near Hawa Mahal and shop for traditional textiles, jewellery and Rajasthani crafts.

Tip: Bargaining is common in local bazaars; keep small change ready.

Day

7

### **Jaipur Heritage Sightseeing & Departure**

Morning visit to Amber Fort (elephant ride or jeep ascent optional) followed by City Palace and Jantar Mantar. Drive past Hawa Mahal for photos. After sightseeing, transfer to Jaipur airport or railway station for onward journey.

Important: Check your departure timing before booking morning activities. This day rounds off your 6 nights / 7 days Rajasthan Pilgrimage package.
