Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Leisure in Jaipur

Arrive at Jaipur (Sanganer/Jaipur Airport). Meet and transfer to your hotel. Relax after your journey and enjoy an orientation briefing. In the evening, take a short walk through the colorful local markets around Hawa Mahal and sample Rajasthani snacks.

Tip: Early arrival helps you adjust and may allow an extra sightseeing window on Day 2.

Day

2

Amber Fort & Royal City Sights

Full-day sightseeing of Jaipur city: visit the magnificent Amber Fort with an optional jeep/elephant approach, the royal City Palace, and the astronomical marvel Jantar Mantar. Stop for photos at Hawa Mahal facade and browse the lively bazaars for textiles and handicrafts.

Family note: Choose a slower-paced tour with breaks for kids at the palace gardens.

Day

3

Jaipur to Pushkar — Sacred Town & Evening Aarti

Drive to Pushkar (approx. 3 hours). En route you may stop at Ajmer (optional) to visit the Dargah Sharif. On arrival, explore the serene Pushkar Lake, visit the rare Brahma Temple, and witness the evening aarti at the ghats.

Pushkar is relaxed and family-friendly; dress modestly at religious sites.

Day

4

Pushkar to Jodhpur — Blue City Introduction

After breakfast, drive to Jodhpur (approx. 4–5 hours). On arrival, check in and enjoy a relaxed evening wandering the old lanes around the Mehrangarh Fort. Savor local delicacies at a rooftop restaurant overlooking the blue-hued cityscape.

Photography tip: Sunset from a rooftop near Mehrangarh offers spectacular city views.

Day

5

Mehrangarh, Jaswant Thada & Umaid Bhawan

Full-day sightseeing in Jodhpur: explore the imposing Mehrangarh Fort (including museum galleries), visit the marble cenotaphs at Jaswant Thada, and drive by the grand Umaid Bhawan Palace. Afternoon at leisure to shop in the vibrant Sardar Market for spices, textiles, and handicrafts.

Day

6

Drive to Jaisalmer — Golden City Arrival

Transfer to Jaisalmer (approx. 5–6 hours). Arrive in the evening and enjoy a first glimpse of the Jaisalmer Fort glowing in golden sandstone. Check into your hotel inside or near the fort and soak in the medieval ambiance.

Tip: Wear comfortable shoes — the fort and bazaars have uneven surfaces.

Day

7

Jaisalmer Fort & Haveli Walks

Explore the treasures of Jaisalmer: walk through the massive Jaisalmer Fort, visit Patwon Ki Haveli, Salim Singh Ki Haveli, and the serene Gadisar Lake. Enjoy a cultural evening with folk music at a local venue or your hotel.

Family-friendly: Short walking distances with many shaded rest stops available.

8

Sam Sand Dunes Camel Safari & Desert Camp

Drive to Sam Sand Dunes for a quintessential desert experience. Enjoy a camel safari across the dunes, watch an unforgettable sunset, and spend the night at a comfortable desert camp with folk performances and a guided stargazing session.

Highlight: Overnight desert camp — a must-do in a Rajasthan tour package.

Jaisalmer to Bikaner — Forts and Karni Mata Option
