Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival in Jaipur & Evening Folk Welcome

Arrive at Jaipur (Sanganer/International Airport or Railway Station). Transfer to your family-friendly hotel and relax. In the evening enjoy a curated welcome experience with traditional Rajasthani hospitality.

- Evening visit to Chokhi Dhani for an immersive folk village experience: puppet shows, folk dance performances, camel rides (optional), and a lavish Rajasthani dinner. Great introduction to Rajasthani culture – ideal for families.

Day

2

Amber Fort, Jaigarh & City Palace Trail

After breakfast, drive to the majestic Amber Fort. Explore its courtyards, Sheesh Mahal (Mirror Palace) and enjoy panoramic views from Nahargarh Fort if time permits.

- Visit Jaigarh Fort (optional cannon and museum) en route. Return to the city to visit the City Palace complex and the astronomical marvel Jantar Mantar. Walk past the iconic Hawa Mahal for photos and stroll through nearby bazaars.

Tip: Morning visits to Amber Fort avoid crowds and midday heat.

Day

3

Sanganer & Bagru Handicraft Workshops

Today is dedicated to hands-on craft trails. Drive to Sanganer and Bagru, famous for textile crafts and block printing.

- Participate in a block-printing workshop (Bagru) – learn traditional wooden block techniques and print a souvenir piece.
- Visit Sanganer artisans to see hand-made paper, kalamkari and printing processes. Enjoy time for textile shopping and visiting small family-run studios.

Note: Workshops are family-friendly; children can join simple printing and craft activities. Comfortable clothing recommended.

Day

4

Artisan Trails, Blue Pottery & Folk Evenings

Explore Jaipur's artisan quarters and specialized studios today.

- Visit a blue pottery workshop to see clay glazing and shaping; try a short pottery demo.
- Meet local jewelers and learn about Kundan and Meenakari work; optional gemstone shopping.
- Afternoon free for leisure or hotel activities. In the evening enjoy a curated Rajasthani cooking demonstration followed by a folk music and dance performance in a heritage setting.

Tip: Carry small change for local markets and be ready to bargain politely at bazaars.

Day

5

Leisure Morning, Market Walk & Departure

A relaxed final morning in Jaipur.

- Enjoy breakfast and a short guided market walk in Johari Bazaar / Bapu Bazaar for last-minute shopping – textiles, handicrafts, spices and souvenirs.
- Transfer to Jaipur Airport/Railway Station for onward travel.
