## Day-by-Day Itinerary

---

Day

1

### **Arrival in Jaisalmer & Fort Check-in**

Arrive at Jaisalmer (by train or road). Transfer to your heritage hotel located within or close to Jaisalmer Fort. Spend the afternoon settling in and enjoying the unique atmosphere of the ramparts.

Activities:

- Orientation and welcome at the hotel
- Short evening walk through the Fort bazaar to experience local crafts and street food

Important: Early check-in subject to availability. Luggage can be stored if rooms are not yet ready.

Day

2

### **Jaisalmer Fort & Havelis Exploration**

Full day dedicated to the UNESCO-style heritage of Jaisalmer. Explore the living fort and the intricate merchant mansions that made the city wealthy.

Activities:

- Guided tour of Jaisalmer Fort (architecture, Jain temples, viewpoints)
- Visit Patwon Ki Haveli, Salim Singh Ki Haveli, and other ornate havelis
- Evening at Gadisar (Gadsisar) Lake for sunset and birdlife watching

Family note: Short, flat walks; stroller-friendly in most areas but some narrow lanes in the fort.

Day

3

### **Heritage Museums & Sunset at Bada Bagh**

Discover local history and lesser-known gems around Jaisalmer.

Activities:

- Morning visit to the Jaisalmer Museum or Folk Museum (optional)
- Afternoon excursion to Bada Bagh — royal cenotaphs with dramatic sunset views
- Quick stop at the abandoned village of Kuldhara to hear the mysterious tales

Tip: Carry water and sun protection; late afternoons are ideal for photos at Bada Bagh.

Day

4

### **Transfer to Sam Sand Dunes – Desert Experience**

Drive from Jaisalmer to Sam Sand Dunes (approx. 45–60 mins). Immerse in desert culture and adventure.

Activities:

- Arrival and check-in at your desert camp (comfortable family tents or glamping)
- Sunset camel safari across the dunes
- Traditional Rajasthani cultural program: folk music, dance, and bonfire dinner

Important: Desert nights can be chilly outside peak winter months; lightweight warm layers recommended at night.

Day

5

### **Jeep Safari / Khuri Explorer & Return to Fort Stay**

Optional early morning desert activities followed by return to Jaisalmer.

Activities:

- Sunrise camel ride or jeep safari into remote dunes (optional add-on)
- Visit Khuri village (local village experience, sand dune play for kids)
- Afternoon return to Jaisalmer Fort for leisure and shopping

Family tip: Jeep safaris are faster and good for families with young children; confirm seat/child safety arrangements in advance.

Day

6

### **Leisure Morning & Departure**

Relaxed final morning in Jaisalmer with time for last-minute photos, souvenirs, and a hearty Rajasthani breakfast.

Activities:

- Breakfast at the fort hotel
- Free time for shopping or optional short visits (textile shops, miniature artists)
- Transfer to railway station or departure point

Note: Check-out times and transfer schedules will be coordinated to match your onward travel plans.
