Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival at Port Blair & Local Orientation

Arrive at Port Blair airport/jetty and transfer to your hotel. After check-in and freshening up, enjoy a relaxed half-day city orientation covering major nearby attractions. Spend the evening exploring local markets and sampling seafood or regional cuisine.

Activities:

- Airport/jetty pickup and hotel transfer
- Visit Corbyn's Cove Beach for a relaxed stroll
- Quick visit to the local market (Aberdeen Bazar) for shopping and snacks

Tip: Early arrivals can request early check-in; otherwise luggage can be stored at the hotel.

Day

2

Cellular Jail Visit & Light and Sound Show

Dedicate the day to the poignant history of the islands at the Cellular Jail. Explore the museum and galleries to understand the freedom struggle. In the evening, attend the iconic Light and Sound Show at Cellular Jail (timings vary by season).

Activities:

- Guided history walk at Cellular Jail (museum & memorial)
- Visit Rajiv Gandhi Water Sports Complex (optional short activities)
- Evening: Light and Sound Show at Cellular Jail

Important: Carry a photo ID for museum entry. Book Light & Sound Show tickets in advance during peak season.

Day

3

Ross Island & North Bay Island Excursion

Full-day boat excursion to Ross Island and North Bay Island. Witness the hauntingly beautiful ruins and greenery at Ross Island, followed by marine experiences at North Bay. Enjoy a glass-bottom boat ride and optional snorkeling to view corals.

Activities:

- Ferry to Ross Island; guided walk amongst colonial ruins
- Transfer to North Bay; glass-bottom boat and optional snorkeling (additional charge)
- Return to Port Blair by late afternoon

Note: Marine activities depend on weather and sea conditions. Snorkeling requires basic fitness and is subject to additional safety briefing.

Day

4

Museums & Chidiya Tapu Sunset

Explore Port Blair's cultural side with visits to key museums and parks, then head to Chidiya Tapu for a spectacular sunset. This day blends learning with natural beauty.

Activities:

- Visit Samudrika Naval Marine Museum and Anthropological Museum
- Stop at Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park viewpoint (photo stop)
- Late afternoon excursion to Chidiya Tapu for sunset and birdwatching

Tip: Carry binoculars for birdwatching at Chidiya Tapu. Museums usually close by 5 PM, so plan timings accordingly.

Day

5

Departure from Port Blair

After breakfast, complete your hotel check-out formalities. Depending on your departure time, squeeze in last-minute shopping or a short city drive. Transfer to Port Blair airport/jetty for onward journey.

Activities:

- Breakfast and hotel check-out
- Last-minute shopping / quick city drive (time permitting)
- Transfer to Port Blair Airport/Jetty for departure

Important: Confirm your onward flight/boat timings and allow sufficient buffer for transfers.
