Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Port Blair Introduction

Arrive at Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair. Transfer to your hotel and relax after your journey. Late afternoon guided visit to Cellular Jail followed by the iconic Light & Sound Show in the evening. Dinner at the hotel or a recommended local restaurant.

Tip: Keep some local cash for small purchases; evenings are best for relaxed shore walks.

Day

2

Baratang Island Journey — Limestone Caves & Mud Volcano

Early morning drive to Baratang Island through scenic forest and coastal stretches. Take a short boat ride and trek to the Limestone Caves, visit the Mud Volcano, and explore local mangrove silhouettes. Check in at your Baratang accommodation and unwind with a simple island dinner.

Note: The day involves long transit and light walking; suitable for families who are comfortable with a full-day outing.

Day

3

Return to Port Blair — Ross Island & Leisure

Return to Port Blair by road. After check-in, enjoy a half-day boat excursion to Ross Island to see colonial ruins, deer sightings, and scenic views. Evening at leisure for shopping at Aberdeen Bazaar or relaxing at the hotel.

Tip: Carry sunscreen and a hat for island walks; shops in Aberdeen Bazaar offer local handicrafts and snacks.

Day

4

Transfer to Havelock (Swaraj Dweep) — Radhanagar Sunset

Morning ferry to Havelock (Swaraj Dweep). Check into your beachside resort. Afternoon at Radhanagar Beach — ranked among Asia's best beaches — enjoy swimming, sunbathing, and the spectacular sunset.

Highlight: Radhanagar Beach is perfect for family photos and relaxed beach time.

Day

5

Water Sports & Marine Adventure – Elephant Beach or Diving

Choose between a guided snorkeling trip to Elephant Beach or an introductory scuba diving session (for certified divers, a full dive available). Explore vibrant coral gardens and marine life. Evening at leisure back at the resort.

Important: Snorkeling is family-friendly; scuba requires prior medical declaration and certification for advanced dives.

Day

6

Leisure Day at Havelock – Optional Activities

A relaxed day to enjoy resort amenities or opt for additional activities: kayaking, guided island hikes, birdwatching, or a second dive. Enjoy fresh seafood at local cafes and a quiet evening by the beach.

Short ferry ride to Neil Island. Explore Laxmanpur Beach at sunrise and the natural rock formation near Bharatpur Beach. Snorkel in calm shallow waters or simply relax on the soft sands. Overnight stay on Neil.

Note: Neil Island is ideal for families seeking calm waters and relaxed beach exploration.

Return to Port Blair – Heritage Evening

Morning ferry back to Port Blair. Afternoon free for leisure or optional visits to the Anthropological Museum or Samudrika Marine Museum. In the evening, enjoy a farewell dinner and, if you missed it earlier, the Cellular Jail Light & Sound Show.

Tip: Museums close in the afternoon; plan visits earlier in the day.

Departure – Transfer to Airport

After breakfast, check out and transfer to Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair for your onward flight. Our representative assists with departure formalities and any last-minute travel help.
