Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival and Kasol Riverside Welcome

Arrive at Bhuntar (Kullu) Airport / Bus Stand and transfer to Kasol (approx. 1.5–2 hours). Check in to your cozy riverside accommodation and relax. Spend the evening exploring the Kasol Market, enjoying coffee at a riverside cafe, and taking a gentle walk along the Parvati River. Ideal to rest and acclimatize; light walking only.

Day

2

Manikaran Pilgrimage & Chalal Village Walk

After breakfast, take a short drive to Manikaran Sahib – visit the Gurudwara and the natural hot springs known for their therapeutic warmth. Return via a scenic walk or short ferry to Chalal Village (a quaint hamlet famous for its music cafes and scenic viewpoints). Evening at leisure in Kasol; enjoy a candlelit dinner for couples.

Tip: Carry a light jacket; pockets and small notes may be useful around the market.

Day

3

Tosh Valley or Optional Malana Excursion

Choose a romantic day trip:

- Option A: Drive to Tosh (via Barshaini) – short village walks, panoramic views of snow-capped peaks, and serene sunset spots.
- Option B (adventurous): Visit Malana – ancient village with unique culture (permit and local guide recommended; road/track can be rough).

Return to Kasol for a relaxed evening. If you prefer trekking, a guided short trek to nearby viewpoints can be arranged (extra cost).

Day

4

Leisure Morning and Departure

Enjoy a relaxed morning – breakfast overlooking the river, last-minute shopping at Kasol Market, and a peaceful riverside walk. Check out and transfer to Bhuntar / Manali for your onward journey. Schedule transfers as per your flight/bus timings.
