Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival & Leisurely Evening Stroll

Arrive in Kasauli (from Chandigarh or nearby hubs). Check into your hotel and relax. In the late afternoon, take a gentle walk on Mall Road to soak in the colonial atmosphere, visit quaint shops, and enjoy tea at a local café. Conclude the day at Sunset Point for panoramic views.

Tip: Carry light jackets for the evening; the temperature drops after sunset.

Day

2

Nature Walks & Heritage Sights

After breakfast, explore the famed Gilbert Trail, an easy, scenic walk amid pine forests offering tranquil views and birdwatching opportunities. Proceed to Monkey Point, the highest ridge in Kasauli, to visit the small temple and enjoy sweeping valley vistas. Evening at leisure with an optional short drive to nearby viewpoints for photography.

Special note: Walks are well-suited for families and seniors; bring comfortable shoes and water.

Day

3

Short Excursion: Solan & Dagshai (Optional)

Take a half-day excursion to Solan — visit local breweries (if open), the Mall Road, and viewpoints. On the way back, stop at Dagshai, a quiet cantonment town with heritage charm and panoramic lookout spots. Return to Kasauli for an evening cultural walk or rest at your hotel.

Tip: If traveling with children, Dagshai's quiet lanes are ideal for a relaxed stroll.

Day

4

Departure via Chandigarh or Next Destination

Enjoy a relaxed breakfast and, time permitting, a final leisurely walk around the hotel precincts or a quick visit to the Kasauli Baptist Church for its historic architecture. Check out and depart for Chandigarh or your onward destination.

Important: Confirm your onward transfer times in advance to avoid delays.
