## Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

### **Arrival at Bhuntar — Transfer to Tirthan Valley & Riverside Evening**

**Arrival & Transfer:** Arrive at Bhuntar (Kullu-Manali) airport or Aut bus stand and drive through the scenic Kullu Valley to Tirthan Valley (approx. 1.5–2.5 hours depending on starting point). Check into your riverside cottage/heritage homestay in Gushaini/Shoja.

**Evening:** Walk along the Tirthan River, relax by the gushing water, and enjoy a family-style Himachali dinner.

**Tip:** Keep travel light for the short transfer. If arriving early, explore the nearby local market in Aut for snacks and essentials.

### **Riverside Leisure, Trout Fishing & Village Walk**

Spend a relaxed day designed for families: gentle riverside strolls, optional trout fishing (arrange permit), and a guided walk through the village to meet locals and learn about traditional Himachali life. Enjoy simple activities suitable for children and elders.

**Included activity:** Introductory angling session with local guide; opportunity to taste freshly cooked trout.

**Note:** Fishing may require a small local fee/permit; children under 12 can join guided nature games free of charge.

### **Excursion to Jalori Pass & Serolsar Lake**

Day trip to Jalori Pass (approx. 1.5 hours drive from Shajha) — a high-altitude pass with panoramic Himalayan views. Short easy-to-moderate trek to Serolsar Lake (about 30–45 minutes) and visit nearby viewpoints. Picnic lunch at the pass or lakeside.

**Activity level:** Moderate — suitable for older children and adults; alternatives available for those preferring to relax at the cottage.

**Important:** Weather at Jalori can change quickly — carry warm layers and waterproofs.

## Great Himalayan National Park (GHNP) Guided Nature Walk

Guided nature walk or short trek inside Great Himalayan National Park (GHNP) – a UNESCO World Heritage site. Learn about alpine flora, birdlife, and conservation efforts from an experienced naturalist. Sightings may include Himalayan birds, medicinal plants, and panoramic valley views.

Family-friendly options: Choose between a gentle nature trail (1–2 hours) or a longer day trek (3–5 hours) with picnic lunch.

Tip: Carry binoculars and a light daypack; children will enjoy the 'nature detective' guided activity.

## Transfer to Naggar – Heritage, Art & Sunset Views

Drive to historic Naggar in the Kullu Valley (approx. 2–2.5 hours). Explore Naggar Castle, the Roerich Art Gallery, and the ancient temples and cobbled lanes. Enjoy sunset views over the Kullu Valley and sample local Kullu cuisine at an evening meal.

Cultural highlights: Learn about Nicholas Roerich's legacy and the ancient trade routes that shaped the region.

Note: Naggar has limited ATM access – carry cash for small purchases and souvenirs.

## Departure from Bhuntar / Extension Options

After breakfast, transfer to Bhuntar (or Kullu) for onward connections by flight or road. Drop-off at Bhuntar airport/bus stand.

Optional extensions: Extend your Himachal Family Retreat tour package with a stay in Manali, a drive to Solang Valley, or an additional night back in Tirthan for deeper nature walks.

Reminder: Confirm onward travel times in advance; if flying, arrive at the airport at least 90 minutes before departure.
