Note: This itinerary is designed for travelers with moderate fitness and some high-altitude experience. Acclimatization days are included to reduce altitude sickness risk.

## Day-by-Day Itinerary

---

Day

1

### **Arrival at Keylong & Acclimatization**

Arrive at Keylong, the administrative center of Lahaul. Transfer to your accommodation and take time to rest and acclimatize. Short walks through the town to explore local markets and the Shashur Monastery surroundings. Brief pre-trip briefing about road conditions and travel plans.

Important: Drink plenty of water and avoid strenuous activity today to aid acclimatization.

Day

2

### **Keylong to Jispa — Scenic Drive Along the Bhaga River**

Drive from Keylong to Jispa (approx. 2–3 hours) following the Bhaga River valley. En route, enjoy sweeping mountain views and stopping for photography. Evening by the riverside in Jispa; optional short hike to nearby viewpoints.

Tip: Carry a light windproof jacket and sun protection — high-altitude sun is strong.

3

### **Jispa to Darcha/Tandi — Entering the High Mountain Corridor**

After breakfast, proceed towards Darcha/Tandi via winding mountain roads. This day's drive offers remote landscapes, dramatic ridgelines, and the feeling of true Himalayan isolation. Check into your guesthouse and enjoy an early evening rest.

Note: Roads can be rough; allow buffer time for transit. Keep essential medication and water accessible.

4

### **Darcha/Tandi to Losar via Kunzum Pass — High Pass Experience**

Cross the iconic Kunzum Pass (4,551 m) today en route to Losar. Marvel at barren, lunar-like landscapes and panoramic vistas. Stop at lookout points for photos and to enjoy the silence of the high plateau. Arrive at Losar for overnight stay and light exploration of the village.

Important: This is a high-altitude day. Move slowly, avoid alcohol, and report any symptoms of altitude sickness to your guide immediately.

## Losar to Kaza — First Impressions of Spiti Valley

A short drive brings you into Kaza, the administrative and cultural hub of Spiti. After arrival and check-in, take a relaxed walking tour of Kaza Bazaar, visit viewpoints for sunset photography, and attend a local orientation about Spiti culture and sites for the next day.

Tip: Try local dishes and warm beverages to combat the cold evening temperatures.

6

## Kaza Local Sightseeing — Villages & Ancient Monasteries

Explore iconic Spiti hamlets: Langza (fossil village and giant Buddha), Hikkim (home to one of the world's highest post offices), Komic (one of the world's highest villages), and Gue (with its preserved mummy). Conclude the day with a visit to Ki Monastery and the monastery complex for sunset views over the valley.

Note: Short walks and easy hikes at altitude; wear sturdy shoes and layer clothing.

## Final Morning in Kaza & Departure

Use the morning for any last-minute sightseeing, shopping in Kaza Bazaar, or an optional short hike to nearby vantage points. After breakfast, begin your onward journey (return to Keylong/Manali or proceed to your next destination). Tour concludes after drop-off.

Tip: Confirm onward transport timings in advance. Carry snacks and warm layers for the return journey.
