## Day-by-Day Itinerary

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Day

1

### **Arrival in Shimla & Leisure Evening**

Arrive at Shimla (or Chandigarh/Train station transfer to Shimla). Meet and greet, transfer to your hotel. Evening at leisure: take a romantic stroll on the Mall Road, visit the Ridge and enjoy views of the lit-up town. Tip: Acclimatize and rest well – the next day starts early for your scenic drive into Kinnaur.

### **Shimla to Sangla – Scenic Drive via Rampur**

After breakfast, depart for Sangla Valley (approx 7–9 hours depending on route and stops). Enjoy changing landscapes: pine forests, terraced fields and apple orchards. Stop at Rampur for a break and photo stops en route. Check-in at your Sangla hotel/resort and enjoy a quiet evening by the river. Travel note: Road conditions vary – comfortable SUV recommended.

### **Explore Sangla & Excursion to Chitkul**

Full day to explore the enchanting Sangla Valley. Drive to Chitkul – the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border – stroll along the Baspa river, visit the quaint wooden houses and enjoy the unspoilt valley atmosphere. Return to Sangla at sunset. Highlights: apple orchards, riverside picnics and local Kinnauri hospitality.

### **Sangla to Kalpa via Reckong Peo**

Drive from Sangla to Kalpa with a stop at Reckong Peo – administrative town of Kinnaur. Visit local markets and viewpoints offering stunning panoramas of Kinnaur Kailash (Jorkanden) peaks. Arrive in Kalpa, check-in and enjoy an evening watching the sunset paints the mountain range. Romantic moment: watch the mountain silhouette at dusk – ideal for honeymooners.

### **Kalpa: Sunrise Views & Village Walks**

Early morning sunrise views of Kinnaur Kailash from your hotel or nearby viewpoints – a must-see. After breakfast, enjoy a leisurely village walk through terraced fields and apple orchards, visit traditional Kinnauri homes and local temples. Optional (extra): Day trip to Nako village and Nako Lake – requires early start and additional drive time.

### **Kalpa to Shimla – Relaxed Return Drive**

After breakfast, begin your return drive to Shimla. En route, pause at scenic spots, enjoy lunch at Rampur or a riverside stop and reach Shimla by evening. Check-in and spend a relaxed night reminiscing over your Kinnaur memories. Tip: Keep some camera battery for the ever-changing Himalayan vistas on the way back.

## Departure from Shimla / Transfer to Next Destination

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to the railway station, airport or Chandigarh for onward journey. If time permits, quick visits or shopping on Mall Road. Wishing you a safe journey – cherish memories of apple valleys and starry nights.
