Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day

1

Arrival, Transfer & Leisure Check-in

Arrive at Manali (private transfer from Delhi/Chandigarh or optional overnight Volvo). Meet-and-greet at the hotel and check-in to your luxury mountain resort. Spend the afternoon relaxing, exploring the property, enjoying the spa, or taking a stroll on Mall Road. In the evening enjoy a welcome dinner and a short orientation by your local host.

Day

2

Manali Local Sightseeing & Heritage Walk

After breakfast, enjoy a curated tour of Manali's highlights: visit the serene Hadimba Devi Temple, explore the ancient Manu Temple, and walk through the Manali Club House and Tibetan Monasteries. Lunch at a charming café. Afternoon free to visit the Vashisht Hot Springs and nearby ancient temples. Return to the hotel for a sunset view of the valley and a romantic candlelit dinner option.

Tip: Carry light woolens as evenings can get chilly even in summer.

Day

3

Solang Valley Adventure & Overnight Stay

Transfer to Solang Valley for a full day of high-adrenaline activities. Enjoy paragliding, ropeway/zipline, ATV rides, and zorbing (activities vary by season). If traveling in winter or when snow is present, experience supervised snow play, beginner skiing, or snow scooter rides. Check into a premium mountain-facing cottage/resort in Solang for one unforgettable night under the stars.

Note: Adventure activities are subject to weather and operator availability; advance booking recommended for paragliding and ropeway slots.

Day

4

Rohtang/Atal Tunnel Excursion (Subject to Permit)

Early morning drive to Rohtang Pass (seasonal and permit-based) or alternatively to the scenic Atal Tunnel – Rohtang route and Gulaba/Marhi viewpoints. Enjoy snow vistas (seasonal) and photography stops. Picnic lunch en route. Return to Manali by late afternoon and relax at your resort. Evening at leisure with optional couple's spa treatment and private dining.

Important: Rohtang Pass requires a permit; if unavailable, the Atal Tunnel and nearby high-altitude meadows provide equally stunning views.

Day

5

Culture & Castles: Naggar, Art, and Relaxation

Today explore the quieter, picturesque side of the valley: a half-day excursion to Naggar Castle – visit local art galleries and the Nicholas Roerich Art Gallery. Stop at Roerich Art Gallery, enjoy panoramic views of the Beas Valley and the Pir Panjal range. Return to Manali for a leisurely evening. Optional activities include river rafting (seasonal) or a private mountain-side bonfire with live local music.

Tip: Naggar's cobbled lanes are perfect for couples' photoshoots.

Day

6

Leisure, Shopping & Romantic Evening

A free day to choose activities: indulge in a signature couple's spa, go shopping at Mall Road for local handicrafts, Kullu shawls, and Pashmina, or take a short hike to Jogini Falls. Prepare for a special farewell dinner – a curated Himalayan gourmet experience with candlelight and valley views.

Note: Shops on Mall Road are open till late evening; bargaining is common at local markets.

Day

7

Check-out & Departure

After a relaxed breakfast, check out from the hotel. Private transfer to your onward destination (Chandigarh/Delhi drop-off or airport transfer). En route photo stops and final scenic vistas. Trip ends with memories of a luxurious and adventurous Himachal Honeymoon package.

Important: Departure timing can be adjusted; we recommend booking an evening return or overnight travel for a relaxed exit.
